CREATIVE WRITING ASSIGNMENTS:

-the students will be asked to do short creative writing assignments throughout the year, applying grammar points learned for that specific assignment.

COMPRHENSION AND ARTICLE ANALYSIS:

-The students will analyze and create articles and newspapers based on research of opinion. There will be tests and/or assignments based on comprehension of articles. They will also need to prepare a three minute speech that must be memorized.

POWER SCHOOL :
